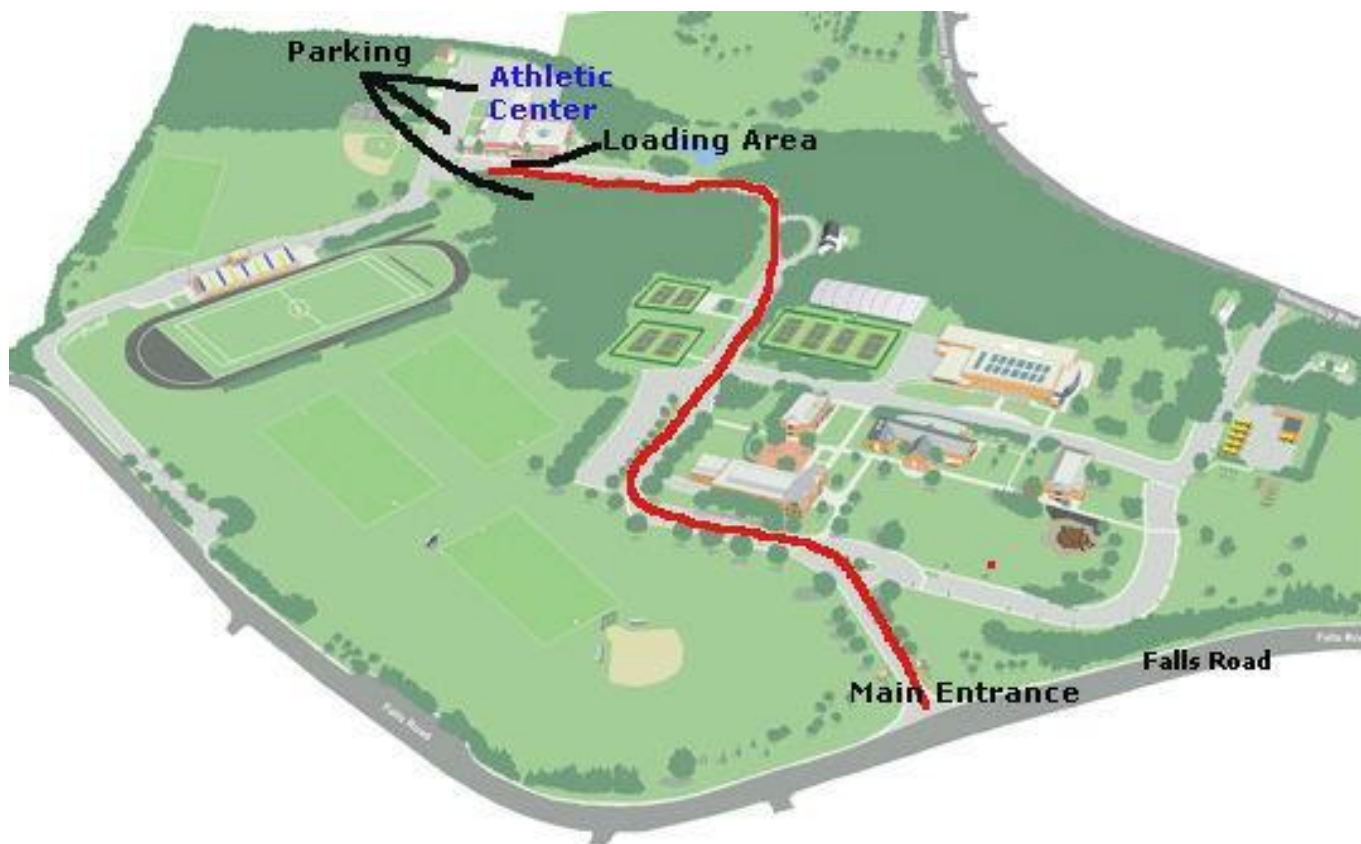

Event Information

Pre-Arrival: Don't forget to bring your Engineering notebook and robot. Everyone that will be going to the pit area will need safety glasses so make sure you have enough for your team and anyone visiting your pit. Team must arrive with Consent and Release forms for all student and adult team-members *or* a roster printed out from the Team Information Management System (TIMS).

Competition Supplies: Be sure to bring an extension cord & utility strip, safety glasses, battery chargers, and spare parts (all marked with your team number).

Arrival: Please report to the check-in table upon arrival. Team check-in will open at 7:00. This will allow us to quickly direct people to the appropriate areas. Have your safety glasses packed separately, so they will be available BEFORE your team enters the pit area. People will not be allowed in the pit area without safety glasses.

Robot Inspection: Please bring your robot to inspection as soon as possible after check-in. Remember to have your team numbers on the robot in large size, and make sure that your robot can accommodate the mounting of the Alliance Flag. Teams must pre-inspect their robots using the Inspection Checklists near the end of Part 1 of the Official Game Manual prior to arriving at the event and BRING PRINTED INSPECTION SHEETS. The Inspection sheet is at the back of game manual 1. Remember to bring the REQUIRED bill of materials for non-TETRIX® parts.

All robots must have a separate Main power switch according to Game Manual Part 1 RE01.

Judging: Teams will be notified of their judging interview and inspection times prior to the tournament. Judging interview times cannot be rescheduled. If your team is in the inspection process they will need to leave and go to judging.

Teams should bring their Engineering Notebook and Control Award Application to the Judging Room. Please remove the Control Award from your Notebook before handing to the Judges. Teams should also bring their robot. Please be sure your team number is on the outside front cover of your Notebook. Teams must pick up their Engineering Notebooks at the end of the day at the Registration Table or other location announced at the Tournament.

Pit Area: Please observe the boundaries of your pit and be kind to your neighbors. The Pit Area should stay clear of obstructions to traffic. Safety glasses must be worn in Pit Area at all times by every person in the Pit Area, this includes team members, coaches, mentors, and all visitors. Anyone not wearing safety glasses will be asked to leave the Pit area. Multiple violations will result in notification to the Judges and Referees. No food will be allowed in the Pit Area. A separate area will be set up for people to eat lunch.

HELP Desk: Wizards.exe will be manning a help desk to help teams with autonomous code, software, and hardware. If your team would like some help during the day please stop by the help desk. If you would like some help prior to the qualifier, contact wizards.exe@gmail.com

Gracious Professionalism: Team members are expected to demonstrate gracious professionalism at all times through their work within and beyond the team environment. Remember, Gracious Professionalism is a way of doing things that encourages high-quality work, emphasizes the value of others, and respects individuals and the community.

We will be having teams nominate other teams for a gracious professionalism award. Forms and a box to place them will be located at pit admin.

First Aid: Please go to the Pit Administration table for basic First Aid supplies and alert the event organizers if more involved care is required.

FLL Jr. Expo: We will also be hosting an FLL Jr. Expo at this event. If you are interested in sharing your FTC experiences or being an ambassador for the Expo, please let us know at check-in. We are looking for 2-4 teams to spend 20 minutes with the FLL Jr. teams.
